Campsis x tagliabuana 'Takarazuka Fresa' PP 23,917

A Campsis that is half the size of other varieties, this is an excellent choice for a small trellis or fence as a focal point or privacy screen. It is versatile and beautiful with:

- Non-stop phenomenal fiery red blooms clustered as bouquets
- A more compact size for smaller urban spaces and containers

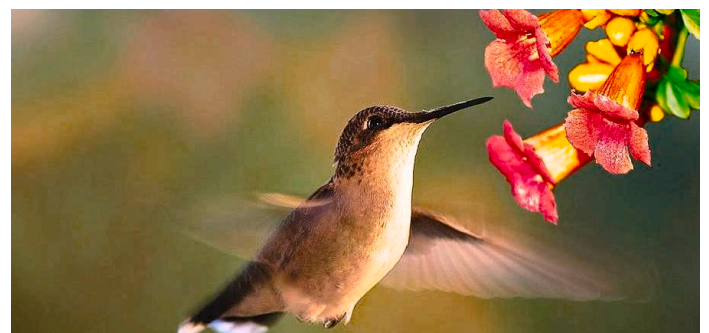

Spirit of ANZAC Grevillea

Grevillea 'Spirit of ANZAC' PP 29,372

This showy evergreen shrub from Australia was bred to commemorate a famous battle fought by the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps (ANZAC). It is stunning with its:

- Large blooms with velvety red stamens and golden yellow centers
- Silvery gray green dissected foliage that contrast well with the blooms
- Vigorous growth and drought tolerance, establishing quickly on slopes

From the breeding program of Digby Growns at Kings Park Botanical Garden, this beauty will draw the eye to the landscape and every hummingbird around!

Flame Thrower® Eastern Redbud

Cercis canadensis 'NC2016-2' PP31,260

In Spring, after stunning pink blooms appear on bare stems, burgundy foliage emerges turning bright yellow and deep green. This small tree is a true breakthrough with its:

- Amazing color of burgundy, red, orange, yellow and lime leaves on one branch
- Beautifully heart-shaped leaves that are less susceptible to leaf scorch
- Smaller stature that commands attention and is perfect for urban gardens
