Merlot Redbud

Cercis canadensis var. texensis 'NC2004-6' PP22297

A small flowering tree that adds dramatic color and contrast, 'Merlot' is beautiful as a specimen or informal hedge. A tough and elegant selection with its:

- Deeper purple new growth, maturing to burgundy and then deep green
- Thicker, glossier leaves and strong juvenile branch structure
- Compact size, perfect for our smaller urban gardens and patios

Adaptable, it grows well in most soils, including clay, and with Texas Redbud in its genes, it is more tolerant of heat and drought. Hummingbirds love it too!

Grey Horizon Emu Bush

Eremophila glabra 'EREM1' PP 29,275

This low-growing, wide spreading shrub has dense, blue-gray velvety foliage and a moderate display of yellow and orange flowers in spring. It is prized for its:

- Vigorous growth; establishes quickly in the landscape
- · Compact and dense prostrate habit
- Drought and heat tolerance

An excellent choice for a groundcover that will add texture and contrast to the landscape with minimal maintenance required.




