

Trinity 2.0™ Mexican Sycamore

Platanus mexicana 'EverWhite'

This variety is distinguished by its reliable uniformity assured through propagation by cuttings from a superior selection and offers further exceptional attributes including:

- Fast-growth and upright, rounded habit
- Large palmately-lobed leaves with silver undersides and subtle fall color
- Exfoliating bark that is uniquely mottled white, tan and gray

A tough tree, it will thrive in high temps, tolerate urban situations and is resistant to diseases, such as anthracnose. It will quickly provide shade for a park or garden.
