

# Pioneer™ Cedar Elm

*Ulmus crassifolia* 'EverAlan' PP 36,522

An Everde Growers® exclusive, this vigorous native of South Central Texas has small, rough, dark green leaves that turn a vibrant yellow in fall and is distinguished by its:

- Upright, narrow form with excellent branch structure
- Strong central leader – unique for this species
- Uniform habit – perfect for street tree plantings

Tough and adaptable, it handles adverse urban conditions such as air pollution, soil compaction and heat with ease while providing shade and structural beauty.
